Latvian composers and performers are a dynamic force in the contemporary music world and composer Peteris Vasks is arguably its most intense voice. His beautiful *Pater Noster* (Our Father) is here complemented by *Zile Zina* (The Tom-tit's Message), Vask's dramatic commentary on Latvia's participation in other people's war. Latvia's complex relationship with Russia includes the influences of the Russian Orthodox Church. Whilst Rachmaninov's *Liturgy* is part of the great tradition of Russian liturgical composers, here we also hear that tradition magically refracted through the eyes of Latvian Arturs

Her soothing voice embraces the melancholy of a yearning mix of English and Portuguese lyrics. The sparkling guitar mastery of Doug and the vocal eloquence of Diana are sublimely supplemented by virtuoso multi instrumentalist, **Stephen Grant**, one of Australia's busiest touring musicians.
