Codes of Choir Conduct:

- 1. Punctual arrival 10 mins before scheduled start time to allow an on-time start with all present.
- 2. No talking during rehearsals or services listen to the Director and always maintain good quality behaviour. With an understanding that the duration and conclusion of the rehearsal depends upon the punctual arrival of all Choral Scholars and the corporate behaviour during the rehearsal.
- 3. Observe and maintain the correct posture when either sitting or standing throughout the rehearsal or service.
- 4. Phones are not to be seen or heard during rehearsals, services or whilst choristers are robed outside the Choir Vestry.

Choir Dress Code:

- Choir dress cassocks and surplices, together with a ruff or cravat, are supplied and should be worn correctly.
- Clean, polished black or brown school shoes are to be worn.
- Black socks or tights are to be worn with robes. No coloured or white socks.
- Black or school-grey trousers, leggings, or skirts with black tights are to be worn under robes. No jeans or light-coloured tracksuit pants. Lightweight trousers are recommended for summer. If the temperature is forecast to be 30°C or above, shorts may be worn with long, black socks.
- Hair must be neatly combed and, where applicable, boys must be cleanly shaven. If hair is longer than shoulder-length, it should be worn brushed and neatly tied back.
- All belongings, such as socks, shoes, jumpers and drink bottles must be taken home and not left in the Choir Vestry.
- Casual clothes may be worn for Wednesday evening rehearsals.
